Educational Law and Policy Committee- Stay Informed ...

In the news, as the new legislators started the session, an alarm was sounded that enrollment for Educator Preparation Programs had dropped 40%. Enrollment in Residency programs has also declined. This means that by 2024-25, there will not be enough newly licensed teachers to replace those expected to retire. Meanwhile, State Superintendent Truitt is proposing a new plan, Operation Polaris 2.0, to revise support for low-performing districts.
